## **AVAILABLE PROGRAMS**

• Health Scholars Program

Scholars gain firsthand experience in both clinical and administrative healthcare settings, becoming an integral part of the care delivery team. Participants assist with basic care for patients alongside nurses, physicians and other healthcare providers. Scholars participate in 250+ hours of direct patient experience.

Junior Health Scholars Program

This program allows high school students between the ages of 16-17 to shadow a current Health Scholar or work independently in the patient care setting dependent on site requirements. Junior Health Scholars observe how care delivery and administrative teams work together to deliver excellent care and explore whether a career in healthcare is right for them.

Care Navigator/Community Health Worker
 Program participants will gain firsthand
 experience working with underserved
 communities to improve health

outcomes. Participants receive training to connect patients with educational resources, community-based opportunities, and more. They will work closely with care coordinators, social workers, healthcare administrators and case managers to support interventions targeted towards special populations including homeless individuals and those diagnosed with chronic conditions.

• Medical Assistant Training Program

MA students will gain the skills and foundational knowledge needed to succeed as a medical assistant in a clinical environment through virtual self-study lectures as well as in-person training guided by experienced professionals in the field. Participants will be prepared for the Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) exam.

Nursing Assistant Training Program

Our CA-approved Nurse Assistant Training Program equips students with the essential skills and certification they need to excel as entry level nurses in the healthcare field. In addition, students gain job placement advantage to work with one of our partnered health systems upon program completion.

Advanced Practice Provider (APP)
 Fellowship

APP Fellowship participants become a provider in a health system that will further develop skills necessary to practice in a highly collaborative primary care setting delivering patient-centered care and improving health outcomes. The program involves weekly didactics, precepted and autonomous patient encounters, specialty rotations, leadership development opportunities and in-person skills labs.
